

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Greetings Parents, Guardians, and Students,

- Making sure your child gets enough sleep. The recommended amounts of sleep are:
 - Age 2: 11-12 hours, not including daytime nap
 - Age 3: 10-12 hours, not including daytime nap
- Establishing a daily routine between after school and bedtime.
